Visit of the Aladja Monastery

The Aladzha rock monastery is situated only a few kilometers south of the Golden Sands sea resorts and is also a part of the Zlatni Pyasatsi natural park. The distance to Varna is 16 km. The entire monastery is considered to date back to the 12th century AC.

Visit of the Roman Thermae or of the city of Varna

It was the largest antic public building in ancient Bulgaria that covers an area of more than 7000 sq. m. It is situated in the Southeastern region of the modern city of Varna, the Roman Thermae, built during the later half of the second century and the early part of the third century AC.

Varna

It is the largest city and seaside resort on the Bulgarian Black Sea Coast and in Northern Bulgaria, third-largest in Bulgaria after Sofia and Plovdiv with a population of 358 000.

The first settlement was called Odessos, of pre-Greek origin, was originally inhabited by a Thracian-Greek community. It was the capital of After the Slavic conquest of the Balkans it was called Varna.
